Risk Management Strategies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Establish lead and tail person to ensure the group stays together -Stay within designated boundaries -Set a leisurely pace to keep better footing -Make sure all participants have understood rules and are willing to comply 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Check all participants clothing and footwear before walk -Make sure there is enough food for the day and extra water 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Ensure suitable clothing is worn -Check weather reports -Do not do walk if weather unsuitable -Have map with all shelter and hut points
